

The 220th General Synod:

HEADLINE: Denomination with 10 Presbyteries Becomes 8! The Canadian Presbytery has determined over the years that keeping all of their work, travel, and finances "north of the border" is more practical. At one time, part of the Northeast Presbytery, the Lord has blessed the Canadian ARP churches so that they are ready to establish a coordinated Synod of the ARP. This actually reflects our early history when the ARP divided into 4 geographic regions. The Synod of the South is the only portion of the ARP that has maintained our ARP identity by not merging with other Presbyterian denominations. Overtime, our denomination grew out of the south to reach all the way to Canada, and will now hive off (eh)!

In related news, we heard from representatives from both the *Iglesia Presbiteriana Asociada Reformada de Mexico* and *the ARP Church of Pakistan*. These two separate national synods identify as ARP, and are establishing churches, hospitals, and schools/seminaries in their part of the world. The Canadian ARP will also bring us future updates and we will also send representatives to our international family of ARP Synods. (FACT: Did you know there are more ARP church members in Pakistan than in America, Canada, and Mexico combined?)

Related to visits, we were also brought fraternal greetings from the OPC, RPCNA, Canadian Reformed Churches, and the United Reformed Churches. (We send delegates to their meetings, too ((when they don't conflict with ours! Looking at you, PCA!)))

The other presbytery that is "no more," is actually being moved into presbyteries on her borders. After nearly a full-days debate on how to handle the "dysfunction" manifesting in the former 2nd Presbytery, this analogy by a minister from 2nd Presbytery rang true: "Sometimes when I'm driving with my family, I need to pull over and rearrange the seating assignments of my children because the trip is not working out. They are still my children, we are still going to the same place, no one gets kicked out, but sometimes a father needs to move the children around to achieve peace." The analogy fits. The churches of the former presbytery are still ARP, they will simply rearrange by joining neighboring presbyteries; they will be situated differently to make the trip more enjoyable.

Synod also passed recommendations about Secret Societies, which includes a set of questions Sessions should use to help members think through whether or not being a member of such is in keeping with Christian commitments.

Synod passed this motion, "...the 220th General Synod explicitly and forthrightly de-clares that Freemasonry is incompatible with Christianity." While the Synod leaves this decision with a person's conscience, the above motion has little room for nuance. It was acknowledged that certain groups have different practices and commitments, even over different regions, so again, this matter remains one of conscience informed by Scripture.

An old document found on our Synod website alluded to the controversial doctrine known as, "The Eternal Subordination of the Son." Questions were raised as to this language being referenced. A study committee has been formed to determine our official view.

Lastly, this was the first Synod I have attended that served wine as an option for the Lord's Supper.
